***Year 4 Multiplication Tables Assessment** – The Year 4 children had to answer 25 times tables questions, each within 6 seconds. 21% scored full marks. The average score was 20.6 (National Average score 20.5)

***Year 1 Phonics** – The Year 1 children have worked really hard on their phonics this year and did very well in the screening test. 84% of the children attained a threshold score or above. (National Average: 79.1%)

***EYFS** – The Reception children have enjoyed a year of varied experiences across many areas of learning. 70.4% achieved a good level of development. (National Average: 67.3%)
