Dear Parents,

I hope this email finds you well and continuing to keep positive.

I am very mindful that most of our Year 2 to Year 5 children will have been absent from school for nearly 6 months as they are unable to return before September. I would therefore like to offer **NON-KEY WORKER CHILDREN** in these year groups a number of face to face opportunities to touch base with us here at the Willows.

We are planning to run three afterschool **OUTDOOR** sessions for each year group. We are inviting the children to attend school in two groups of 15 or less per year cohort, with staggered starts and finishes (3.40pm-4.40pm and 3.45pm-4.45pm). They will have some circle time with their teachers and a play time with friends in their group. We will ensure all social distancing and other Covid-19 restrictions are in place (we will use the canopies on the playground if it rains).
