Dear Parents,

As you will know, we strive to develop multiple opportunities for children at The Willows to develop their physical health through PE and Sport. As school PE coordinator, I hope that you and your families are managing to stay active during these unprecedented times, and that some of the resources I have posted over the last few weeks on social media and on the school website have been helpful in this regard.

As you may also know, we work very closely with the Trafford School Sport Partnership (Trafford SSP) to provide the children with competitions, events and other exciting opportunities in PE and school sport. Trafford SSP would like to 'Give every child their sports day' this half term, through a 'Virtual Inter School Challenge.' I would like the school to enter this challenge.

Children in Primary Schools across Trafford will be asked to complete 6 simple challenges, and record and submit their scores, should they wish to.

Children at home can complete the activities set out on the PowerPoint, developed by Trafford SSP, which can be found on the 'Class Pages' area of the school website. This PowerPoint sets out 6 very simple challenges, which range in difficulty from EYFS to Upper Key Stage 2. We would like you to choose a day and time convenient to you as a family on the week beginning Monday June 29<sup>th</sup> 2020, and complete the physical challenges. Once you have completed the tasks simply write down your score! If you wish to enter your score to go towards our school points total, simply follow the link, again posted on the Class Pages area of the school website, to take you to a Survey Monkey site. I have been advised that the Survey Monkey site will be down for maintenance on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020, so it will not be possible for scores to be entered then. Please note that you will only be asked to input your **child's name of school, age range, scores for each event** and finally **first name only**. Families with more than one child will need to input scores for each child that attempts the challenge. Results will be announced on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

Children in school will follow the exact same PowerPoint of activities, and again we will do it at convenient times throughout the week, and log our scores.

I hope that you will agree that this is a wonderful opportunity to bring our school community together once again. One of the six 'School Games Values' is 'Teamwork' and I think that this event helps to re-enforce that value to the children through PE and Sport.
