<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To know what type of clothing that is needed for different holidays (What would you pack if you were going somewhere hot versus somewhere cold?)</li> <li>To analyse how own clothes are made/materials used and the type of stitching</li> <li>To use a basic running stitch on different swatches of materials</li> <li>To recognise the work of famous clothes designers and design items of clothing for their favourite teddy (or the teacher's favourite teddy)</li> <li>To make this item of clothing and evaluate effectiveness once complete</li> <li>To celebrate and critique during a teddy bear fashion show and link their designs to work of a famous designer</li> </ul>
