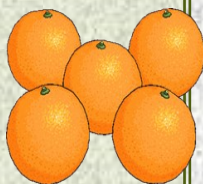

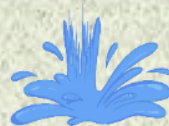

French grammar points

1. When describing something in French the sentence structure is different to how we say it in English e.g. 'bright green' would be 'green bright' in French.

2. French words are spelt differently depending on whether the noun is masculine or feminine e.g. 'big' is spelt grand (m) but grande (f) in French. This can also change the pronunciation.
